
Quilt Joy

Shopping List

45 assorted 2.5" charm squares (Use 1 green one for the center with assorted reds if desired)

1/8 yd green

½ yd background

¼ yd binding


Cutting

Green: 8 1.5" x 1.5"


Background: 36 2.5" x 2.5", 12 1.5" x 6.5", and 4 1.5" x 20.5"

Sewing

1. Sew 5 assorted red 2.5" squares and 4 background 2.5" squares together into a Nine Patch block. Make 9 blocks. If desired, place a green 2.5" square in the center of 1 block for the quilt center.




2. Sew 2 background 1.5" x 6.5" strips and 3 blocks together, alternating them as shown. Make 3.




3. Sew 2 green 1.5" squares and 3 background 1.5" x 6.5" strips together into a row. Make 2.




4. Sew the block rows from step 3 between the sashing rows from step 2 to make the center of the quilt.



5. Sew a 1.5" x 20.5" background strip to each side of the quilt center.



6. Sew green 1.5" squares to each end of the remaining 2 border strips, then sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt.



Finishing

Layer Quilt Joy with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the quilt in the method you prefer. Don't forget a label on the back.
